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Vinyl Field Replacement / Repair Procedure

For loose vinyl strips:

- 1) Follow instructions 5 and 6 below.

Installation of replacement vinyl strips

- 1) Remove vinyl strips to be replaced using a pair of needle nose type pliers to pull vinyl out of track (to aid in removal of damaged vinyl, split vinyl length-wise using a razor knife).
- 2) Completely clean the track area of adhesive and debris.
- 3) Lay vinyl insert over the track making sure to overhang the ends by 1-2 inches.
- 4) Insert one side of vinyl under the rail lip. Using your hands or a blunt instrument like a spline roller, place pressure along the loose edge until it slips into place. If vinyl is too rigid, try sliding the vinyl in from one side with both edges under the rail lip.
- 5) Pull back about 8-10 inches on one end.
- 6) Apply adhesive under both lips and press vinyl back into place. Allow adhesive to cure before proceeding. (adhesive curing times will vary with temperature and climate)
- 7) After adhesive has cured, trim the excess vinyl strips off so they are flush with the rail edge.
